

## **HOUSE WREN NESTING GUIDE**

## **HOUSE WREN NESTS**

- House Wrens generally have two broods per season; a third may be attempted but will likely not be as successful.
- Nest building begins mid-May through late June and can result in the building and rebuilding of multiple 'dummy nests' by the male. Once the female selects a mate and nest site, she will deconstruct and rebuild the male's nest, often using the same building materials. The female's nest will be completed quickly, in as little as 3 days and as many as 14 days.
- One egg is laid per day in the early morning, for 5-8 in total. It may be difficult to get an accurate count of eggs (and later, hatchlings) due to the large volume of nesting material used, mostly twigs and small sticks.
- Female broods the eggs about 12-13 days, starting when the next to last egg is laid. Count this as the first day of brooding.
- Hatching may occur over a 1 to 2-day period and both parents will feed their babies. Runts may be left behind to die.
- Hatchlings fledge about 12-18 days after hatching, usually 16-18, and may occur over a 4-day period. Hatchlings are prone to premature fledging if monitored late in the fledging period. Recommend not opening box from the 10<sup>th</sup> day of hatching.
